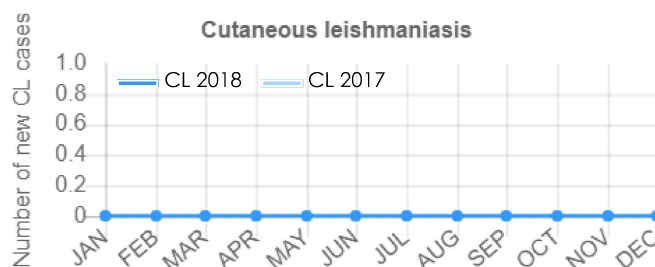
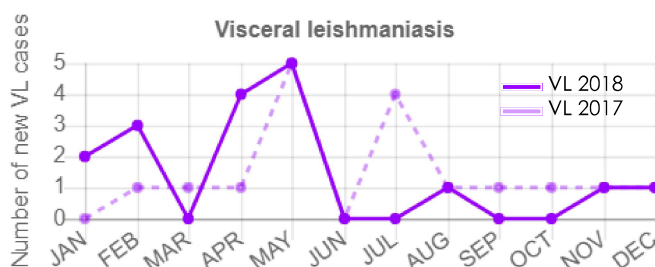

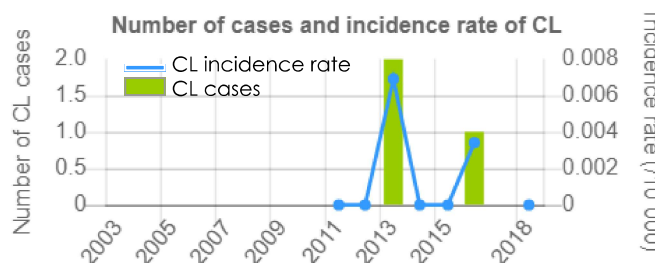
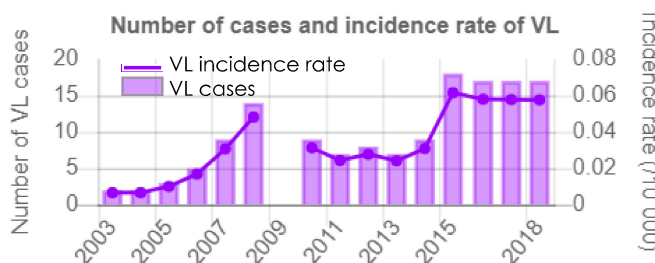

## Number of new cases and Incidence rate/10,000 at the national level from 2003 to 2018

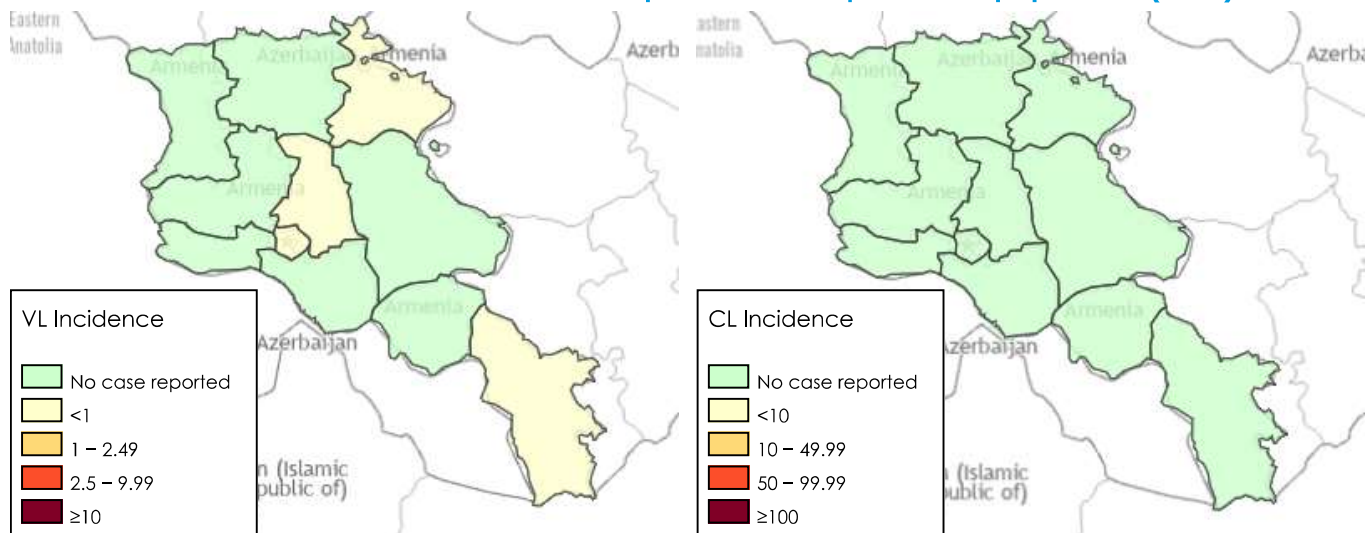
